### WELCOME TO THE FOURTH OF JULY PARADE CODE OF CONDUCT

1. All non-licensed vehicles participating in the parade must be dropped off at the Start of the parade route (Woodsville Elementary School) and must be picked up at the CCX parking lot across from the Wells River Congregational Church. It is ILLEGAL to drive on the main road after the parade ends.
2. Due to safety concerns, please do not throw items i.e. candy, balls, gifts & giveaways of any sort from MOVING vehicles. Walkers may hand it out along the parade route.
3. Excessive force (squealing and smoking of tires) will not be tolerated, and the police will take action.
4. Sirens, horns, etc, may be used in moderation on the New Hampshire side of the parade, but the Wells River side has requested that there be no sirens during that portion of the parade. (per Orange County Sheriff's Department)
